Shurgard obtains a building permit for a self-storage property in London

LUXEMBOURG – Shurgard, the largest developer, owner and operator of self-storage centers in Europe – has received a building permit for a new storage facility in Bow (central east London).



This new c. 85,000 sq ft building will offer approximately 1,500 self-storage units to the London area and is set to open by year-end 2021.

After the successful completion of this project, Shurgard will be offering selfstorage in 34 properties in London and the Thames Valley, representing 2.0 million square feet.

Shurgard is the largest provider of self storage in Europe. The company owns and/or operates 244 self-storage centers and approximately 1.2 million net rentable square meters in seven countries: the Netherlands, France, Sweden, the United Kingdom, Belgium, Germany and Denmark.

Shurgard's European network currently serves 165,000 customers and employs approximately 750 people. Shurgard is listed on Euronext Brussels under the symbol "SHUR".
