## The Consortium led by Sonae has secured the control of Musti

Sonae SGPS SA ("Sonae") informs that, in the scope of the ongoing voluntary public tender offer (the "Offer") for all Musti Group Plc ("Musti" or "Company") issued and outstanding shares ("Shares"), launched by its subsidiary, Flybird Holding Oy (the "Offeror"), and following the acquisition of Shares in the market, the Offeror has already secured 50.10 per cent of all issued Shares. This stake considers the total acceptances received during the Offer period which ended on 15 February 2024, together with the Shares acquired or held by the Offeror (including the Shares to be contributed to the Offeror by the Consortium members).

As previously announced by Sonae on <u>20 February 2024</u><sup>1</sup>, the Offeror has started a subsequent offer period for the Shares in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Offer (the "Subsequent Period"), which is set to expire on 06 March 2024, and its preliminary results are expected to be known on 07 March 2024.
