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For ALTRI, SGPS, S.A. (hereinafter "ALTRI" or "ALTRI GROUP") the benefits arising from a culture of diversity and inclusion are fundamental and that culture is intended to enclose the acting guidelines for all its agents who constitute it.

For this reason, the present commitment presents a structured action that aims to consolidate in the Group a social paradigm of balanced representativeness.

Attracting and retaining the best profiles of the most diverse technical capabilities within our industry, with different genders, ages, cultures and experiences stimulates the organization, develops new skills, enhances knowledge, increases the satisfaction of collaborators, the quality of work and the creation of value by the Group.

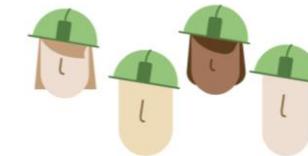
The fundamental objective of ALTRI 2026 Equality Plan ("PLAN FOR GENDER EQUALITY") is to contribute furthermore to achieving effective equality of opportunity between women and men, promoting the elimination of sex discrimination and fostering a healthy balance between personal, family and professional life, so that collaborators feel even more committed to the Group.

It applies to all collaborators of the ALTRI GROUP, including the respective governing bodies of all companies of the ALTRI GROUP (hereinafter, abbreviated and jointly designated by "Collaborators").

The Ethics Committee – which incorporates members of the Board of Directors and the Supervisory Board, as well as people from the Legal and People and Talent Directorate – is the entity responsible for the preparation, revision and implementation, and monitoring of the Plan for Equality. This Committee comprises a total of six members, four women (67%) and two man (33%).

Diversity and inclusion are part of our **VALUES** and are present in several programs joined by ALTRI in full commitment:

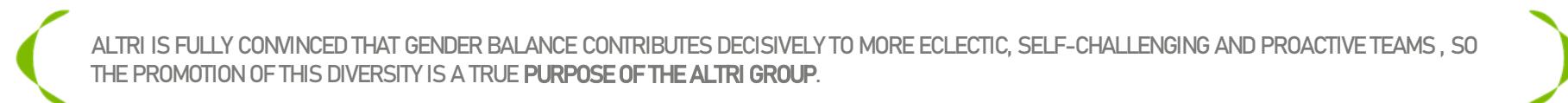
- The **United Nations Global Compact program**, which is committed to aligning the strategy and reflecting in the culture the 10 fundamental principles that embrace Human Rights, Labor Practices, Anti-Corruption Mechanisms and Environmental Protection;
- **Commitment 2030**, promoting the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (**SDGs**) whose aim is to end poverty, protect the environment and promote prosperity and well-being by 2030. ALTRI has consolidated its commitment to setting ambitious targets, in particular in this area: *“Duplicate the number of women in leadership roles from 19 in 2018 to 38 in 2030”* - currently (as of September 2025) this number is 45 women;
- The United Nations **Universal Declaration of Human Rights** - reflected in the ALTRI Code of Ethics in its 2022 revised version - in which the CEO's guide for Human Rights is a call for action for the partners of the World Business Council for Sustainable Development (**WBCSD**), who share a vision of how companies are fulfilling their corporate human rights responsibility and business best practices in this subject.
- ALTRI has published and made it public the Human Rights Policy, the Policy of Participation in the Communities and the Code of Conduct for Preventing and Tackling Harassment.

The Board of Directors of ALTRI, without losing the thread of meritocracy, **promotes diversity policies at various levels:**

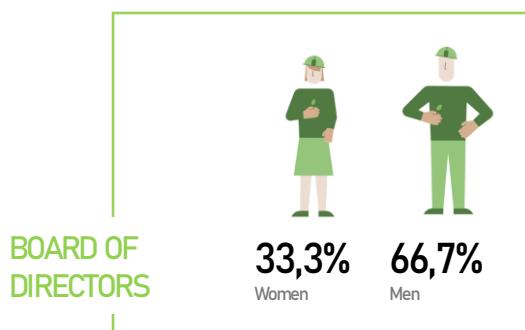
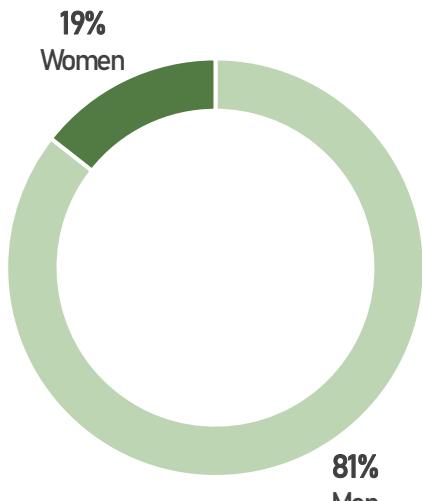
- Career progression policies, performance assessment and salary reviews based on diversity;

- Operational instructions for multidisciplinary teams formed in the context of the most diverse projects to be constituted on the basis of the concern for a balanced representation.

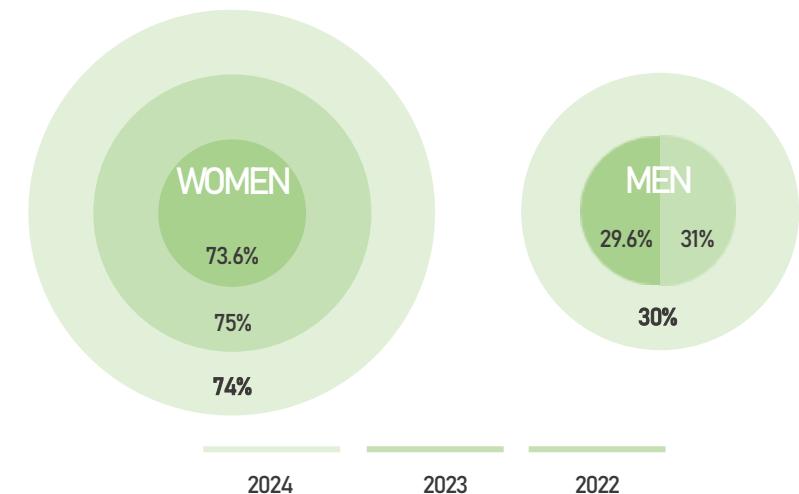
The origin of the Group dates back to 2005, and the policies and actions established herein make this union and purpose stronger, in a heterogeneous and diverse environment characteristic of this industry.

Diversity and gender equality are a concern that ALTRI GROUP recognizes as current and relevant and while our areas of activity – eminently industrial – are historically more prone to the predominance of men, we have for several years defined and implemented measures that materialize a **greater gender equality**.

This **PLAN FOR GENDER EQUALITY** is aligned with the principles, values and standards that are inherent to the different national and international instruments applicable to this topic and aims to underline the **COMMITMENT THAT ALTRI TAKES UNEQUIVOCALLY, PROMOTING MANAGEMENT POLICIES WHICH FAVOR EQUALITY, INCLUSION AND NON-DISCRIMINATION.**

For the implementation of the plan, ALTRI followed the guidelines disclosed for this purpose in the "Guide to the Development of Equality Plans (Annual)", made available by the CITE - Committee on Equality at Work and Employment, prepared in the light of the provisions of the Normative Order no. 18/2019, of 21 June, and that determines the production of a Guide for the preparation of annual equality plans, in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of article 7 of Law no. 62/2017, of 1 August.

The Guide includes three matrices - the Matrix of support to the diagnosis, the Matrix of support to the monitoring of the implementation of the plan for equality, and the Matrix of verification of the implementation of the plan for equality and compliance with the recommendations of CITE. The matrices integrate five main areas:

- Equality in access to employment;
- Equality in working conditions;
- Equal pay;
- Protection in parenthood;
- Healthy balance between professional life and family and personal life.

THE PLAN UNDER PRESENTATION:

- › **RECOGNIZES** and **PRIORITIZES** equal opportunities for women and men as a basic right and assumes the commitment to the implementation of cross-cutting policies that make this right an unavoidable reality with a true positive impact in the life of Collaborators;
- › **REDUCES** current imbalances and prevents imbalances in the future by sorting priorities and matters on which improvements are needed;
- › **PROMOTES** a change in the organizational culture to enhance equality and an effective commitment to the spending of the necessary amount for its achievement.
