Shareholders representing 79,99 percent of the issued share capital of the company were represented. The board of directors appointed attorney Klaus H. Lindblad to chair the meeting.

The following resolutions were passed unanimously:

- 1. Amendment of company name from "Waste Plastic Upcycling A/S" to "WPU Waste Plastic Upcycling A/S" to reflect the actual use of the name.
- 2. Authorization of the Board of Directors of the Company to adopt and issue a warrant program for the benefit of the employees and leadership of the company and its subsidiaries,
- 3. Election of Deloitte Statsautoriseret Revisionspartnerselskab, Copenhagen, CVR-nr.: 33 96 35 56, as auditor for the company.
