

NOVA AUSTRAL OWNERSHIP CHANGES

Punta Arenas, September 25th, 2024. As per the Judicial Reorganization Agreement of Nova Austral S.A. (the "Company"), dated January 17th, 2024 (the "JRA") which was confirmed pursuant to the Court of Appeals of Punta Arenas' ruling dated August 8th, 2024, the Larta investment group took today control of 100% of the Company's shares. With this, the JRA deploys its full effects, and the debt restructuring becomes fully effective triggering, among other effects, the cancelation of all the outstanding bonds, which would allow the company to have financial viability.

In addition, due to the change of control of the Company's ownership, a new board of directors was formed, composed of: Cesar Barros, Maximo Latorre y Anton Felmer.
