WALDORF ENERGY FINANCE PLC

Reference is made to the announcements by WEF on 12 December 2025, on 22 January 2026 (the “**22 January 2026 Announcement**”), on 6 February 2026 and on 12 February 2026 (together the “**Announcements**”), in each case in connection with the Transaction. Capitalised terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings given to them in the Announcements.

As set out in the 22 January 2026 Announcement, the Company intends to apply to and appear before the Court of Session, in Scotland (the “**Court**”), for orders granting permission to convene a meeting of each class of Plan Creditors for the purpose of considering and, if thought fit, approving the Restructuring Plan at the First Hearing. The First Hearing is scheduled to take place before Lord Lake at the Court (Parliament House, Parliament Square, Edinburgh, EH1 1RQ), Court 6 at 10:00 a.m. GMT on 16 February 2026.

Next Steps

Following the First Hearing and subject to the Court granting an order convening meetings of each class of Plan Creditors, the Company intends to convene such meetings to consider and, if thought fit, approve the Restructuring Plan. Thereafter, the Company intends to (i) report the results of the meetings to the Court and seek a further order for authority to serve and advertise the petition and to fix a period for any interested party, if so advised, to lodge answers, and (ii) apply to and appear before the Court on or after 5-8 May 2026 for orders sanctioning the Restructuring Plan.

Further announcements and updates in relation to the Transaction will be provided to investors in due course.
