The index then selects companies with the highest ESG scores and then the highest Free Float Market capitalisation from Euronext® Eurozone 300 index, Euronext® North America 500 index listed in the United States of America and Euronext® Asia Pacific 500 index listed in Japan. The index serves as an underlying for structured products, funds and exchange traded funds.

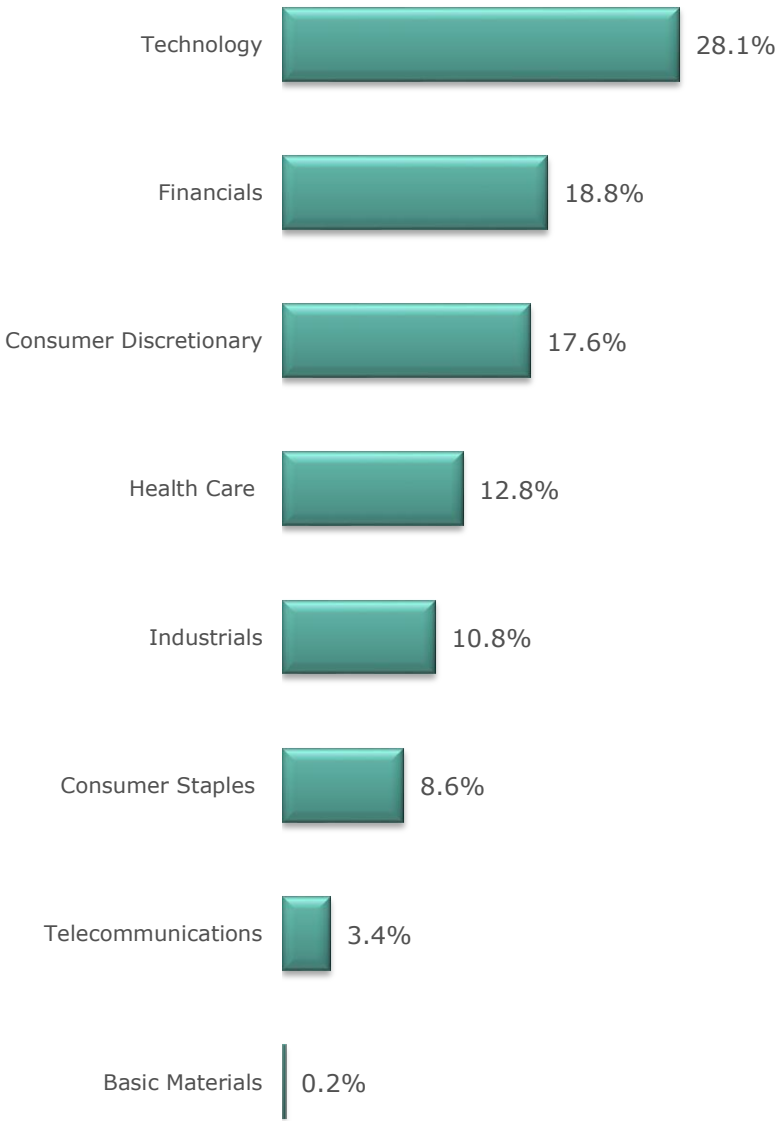
