This document is applicable to the CAC 40 Inflation Adjusted Indices ("Index Family"), which consists of all the Indices as mentioned in the Reference Table.

The Index Family is designed to reflect the price level trends in the trading of shares listed in Europe.

Euronext Paris is the Administrator of this Index Family.

3. CALCULATION

3.1 DEFINITION AND COMPOSITION OF THE INDEX

The CAC 40 Inflation Adjusted index family tracks the performance of the underlying index, with the performance adjusted once a month for the inverse change in 3-month lagged Consumer Price Index – All Households - France – Overall excepting tobacco (INSEE Identifier 001763852).

3.2 CALCULATION OF THE CAC 40 INFLATION ADJUSTED INDEX FAMILY

The general formula of the CAC 40 Inflation Adjusted Index is defined as follows:

$$I_t = \left[\frac{U_t}{D} \right] * N_t$$

Where:

I_t = Index value on Business Day t

U_t = Underlying index close level on Business Day t

D = Divisor = $\begin{cases} 47.5492 & \text{if the underlying index is the CAC 40} \\ 67.2577 & \text{if the underlying index is the CAC 40 NR} \end{cases}$

$$N_t = N_{t-1} * \frac{CPI_{Month(t-1)-3}}{CPI_{Month(t)-3}}$$

where

$N_0 = 1$

$CPI_{Month(i-1)-3}$ = Index CPI value for the 3rd month in the past (3 months from the month of the Business Day i-1)

$CPI_{Month(i)-3}$ = Index CPI value for the 3rd month in the past (3 months from the month of the Business Day i)

N_t is rounded to the 8th decimal.

3.3 EXCEPTIONAL MARKET CONDITIONS AND CORRECTIONS

3.3.1 Unavailability of the underlying index level

In case the level of the underlying index is not available during a period outside the regular closing time of the Euronext markets, the level of the index will not be calculated.

If the unavailability extends over the closing auction time of the Euronext markets, the closing value of the index will be the last level known before the unavailability of the underlying index.

3.3.2 Procedure for Suspension

If an index is **suspended**, the Compiler will confirm the index level to be considered as the closing index value at the market close.

4.1 BASE CURRENCY

The Base Currency of this index family is Euro.

4.2 PUBLICATION

The index is calculated based on the most recent prices of transactions concluded on Euronext Markets. The level of the index is in principle published every 15 seconds. The index is calculated from 09:00 hours CET until Euronext Markets stop regular daytime trading on the days when Euronext Markets are open for trading.
