2.2 REVIEW SELECTION

Step 1: Index Universe

Index Universe definition

The Index Universe consists of companies admitted to listing on Euronext Dublin or Euronext Growth Dublin.

Step 2: Eligibility screening at reviews

Daily Review:

Companies are eligible as of the second day of trading. Companies incorporated outside of their Market Of Reference for which not all trading takes place on Euronext, are not eligible at the Daily Review. Companies incorporated in Northern Ireland are also included the second day of trading.

For the sector indices, only those Companies that are classified in the relevant ICB Industry are eligible.

Changes in Industry classification will be reflected in the applicable sector index in accordance with the official notice.

Semi-Annual Review

Companies of which the Country of Incorporation differs from the country that corresponds to the Market of Reference and whose (extrapolated) velocity is less than 3% are not eligible. The velocity threshold is not applied for Companies solely admitted to listing on Euronext or Companies for which Euronext is the main place of listing or for companies incorporated in Northern Ireland.

Step 3: Selection Ranking

All eligible Companies are selected for the Indices.

3.4 ANNUAL SECTOR INDEX CREATION OR DISCONTINUATION

Sector indices are published based on the ICB classification for each Industry code. If a sector index (Industry code) lacks, it will be published from 1 February with a base date of 1 January of that year and a base level of 1000. Indices that have no constituents are discontinued from the date of delisting or reclassification.
